

WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Winchester (Sleepers Hill) (Prohibition of Heavy Traffic) Order, 1963

The City of Winchester (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Winchester City Council propose to make and submit to the Minister of Transport for confirmation where necessary Orders under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To prohibit subject to the usual exceptions the waiting of vehicles between 9 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on either side of the lengths indicated of the following streets:

- (a) Hyde Street throughout its entire length.
- (b) Little Minster Street throughout its entire length.
- (c) Sussex Street throughout its entire length.
- (d) St Swithuns Street from its junction with Southgate Street to a line between the western boundary of No. 24 and the Close Wall.

2. To prohibit the use of Sleepers Hill by vehicles exceeding two tons in unladen weight except fire engines and vehicles delivering to premises in the road.
