The Queen has been graciously pleased to approve the following award in recognition of gallant and distinguished services in Brunei.

MILITARY MEDAL

On the 12th February 1963, in Brunei, Sergeant Lalbahadur Rana, in command of a small patrol, discovered a rebel's resting place from which fresh tracks led away. As night was coming on he was unable to follow up these tracks for more than 700 yards. The next day, in spite of heavy rain during the night, the tracks were picked up and followed for about 1,500 yards until they were lost. Sergeant Lalbahadur thereupon started to look in likely places for a camp.

Suspecting the presence of rebels while leading his men down a stream, he halted his patrol and sent off half of them to act as a cut off party. He then crawled forward, with one man, to investigate. Suddenly he was fired on from his front. He returned the fire and, at the same time, the man with him engaged a second rebel. In the ensuing fight two rebels were killed, one by Sergeant Lalbahadur himself. Three shot guns and packs were captured but, in spite of a vigorous follow up, a third rebel escaped. The success of this action was entirely due to Sergeant Lalbahadur's determination, skilful leadership and personal courage. It raised the morale of the local people and was an indirect cause of rebel surrenders in the Temburong District.
