PRESENT,

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council
Whereas there was this day read at the Board a
Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords
Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 24th day
of June 1963 (N.P. 2104/63) in the words following,
viz.:

"Whereas by section 3 of the Naval and Marine
Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, and section 1 of the
Naval and Marine Reserves Pay Act, 1957, it is
enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions or other
allowances in the nature thereof payable in respect of
service in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Forces to a
person being or having been an Officer, Seaman
or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner and
subject to such conditions and provisions as are from
time to time directed by Order in Council:

"And whereas by Orders in Council dated 6th
February 1922, and 11th October 1923, we were
empowered at our discretion to award additional
retired pay or disability retired pay or pensions to
Officers, Petty Officers. Non-commissioned Officers
and Men of Your Majesty's Naval and Marine and
Reserve Forces who are invalided out of the Service
on account of sickness or injury certified as attribut-
able to service prior to the 3rd September 1939, on
the scales and under the conditions prescribed
therein:

"And whereas by Orders in Council dated 2nd
February 1937, 9th May 1940, 17th September 1942,
22nd July 1943, 29th November 1946, 8th October
1957, 11th September 1958, and 14th April 1961,
certain improvements were made in the rates of dis-
ability retired pay, pensions and allowances payable
to Officers, Petty Officers, Non-commissioned Officers
and Men of Your Majesty's Naval, Marine and
Reserve Forces:

"And whereas with the approval of the Lords
Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury, payments
have been made to pensioners in receipt of disability
pensions and allowances from the Admiralty at the
same rates and subject to the same conditions as
have been authorised for similar pensioners receiving
