*The County Borough of Bury (Parking Places)
Order 1963*

Notice is hereby given that the Bury County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and subsection (2) of section 11 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to provide for the regulation of off-street car-parks in the Borough, and in particular:

- (1) For the regulation of:
 - (a) The position in which vehicles may wait in any car-park.
 - (b) The class of vehicle which may use such car-park, and
 - (c) The days and hours of operation of each car-park and the period for which any vehicle may wait therein.
- (2) For the prohibition of the use of the car-park for carrying on any trade or business therein, or for the offering for sale or hire of any services, or the loading or unloading of any vehicle.
- (3) For the removal of any vehicle left in a car-park in contravention of the Order.
- (4) For the disposal of vehicles which appear to have been abandoned on any car-park.
- (5) For the recouplement of any costs incurred by the Council in implementing the provisions of the Order.

The Order will apply to the off-street car-parks situate in Bolton Street, Paradise Street, Knowsley Street and Union Square, Bury.

*The City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 8)
Order, 1963*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Worcester propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which will be to restrict the waiting of vehicles to 45 minutes in any period of two hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on weekdays in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
