*Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire intend to apply to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making, under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, of an Order, the effect of which will be that the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice shall become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.

Any objection to the making of the Order should be sent to the Clerk of the County Council at the County Hall, Wakefield, not later than the 19th August 1963.

Whixley Lodge and Whixley... (C.196)	Nidderdale Rural ...	From a point 70 yards east of its junction with the Walshford, Cattal and Whixley County Road, C.56, near the Anchor Inn to a point 120 yards north of Braker Lane at Whixley, a distance of approximately 1,000 yards
Walshford, Cattal and Whixley (C.56)	Nidderdale Rural ...	From a point 40 yards north of Rudgate Grove at Whixley to a point 115 yards south of its junction with the Whixley Lodge and Whixley County Road (C.196) a distance of approximately 285 yards.
Frank's Lane, Whixley ... (Unclassified)	Nidderdale Rural ...	From its junction with the Whixley Lodge and Whixley County Road (C.196) south of the school at Whixley northwards for a distance of approximately 170 yards.
West Lane, Whixley ... (Unclassified)	Nidderdale Rural ...	From its junction with Frank's Lane north-westwards then south-westwards via the branch road to its junction with the Whixley Lodge and Whixley County Road, C.196, at the western end of Whixley Village, a distance of approximately 400 yards.
Great Preston and Kippax ... (C.284)	Tadcaster Rural ...	From the west side of the railway bridge at Kippax Station to the Garforth Urban District boundary near Waddington's Row at Great Preston, a distance of approximately 267 yards.

*The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Traffic Regulation) Orders*

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th July 1963 the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire made Orders under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, which have the following effect:

1. The institution of a system of one-way traffic on the length of Ackworth Road (B.6421) at Purston, in the Featherstone Urban District, between its junction with Hall Street and its junction with Wakefield Road requiring traffic to proceed only in a north-westerly direction towards Wakefield Road.

2. The prohibition of waiting by vehicles, with certain exceptions, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. from Good Friday to the 30th September inclusive in each year on the northern side of a length of 103 yards of Lidgate (B.6422) co-extensive with the frontage of the Recreation Ground at South Kirkby, in the Hemsworth Rural District.

3. The institution of a system of one-way traffic on the length of Lodge Lane, Delph, from the junction with Ainley Wood to a point where Lodge Lane forms a junction with Springwood Estate and Friermere Road, Delph, in the Saddleworth Urban District, requiring traffic to proceed only in a north-westerly direction.

4. (The prohibition of waiting by vehicles, with certain exceptions, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the south side of the road on even dates and on the north side of the road on odd dates of the length of Barnsley Road (B.6422) between the junction with High Street and a point opposite the eastern end of West End Terrace at South Elmsall, in the Hemsworth Rural District.

Copies of the Orders and of maps showing the lengths of roads affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the County Hall, Wakefield (Room 87).
