WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Made-up Textiles Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Made-up Textiles Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for (1) varying the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Made-up Textiles Wages Council (Great Britain) Wages Regulation (Holidays) Order 1952 (Order M.T.(36)) as amended by the Second Schedule to the Wages Regulation (Made-up Textiles) Order 1962 (Order M.T. (52)) and (2) the revocation of Order M.T. (36).

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within 14 days from 5th November 1963. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Made-up Textiles Wages Council (Great Britain), Ebury Bridge House, Ebury Bridge Road, London S.W.1. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections.
