### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1962

*Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way  
County of West Sussex*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 155 of the Town

and Country Planning Act 1962, has prepared in draft and proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over part of King's Crescent and part of King's Drive, Shoreham-by-Sea.

Copies of the draft Order and of the map relative thereto showing the land over which the rights of way proposed to be extinguished subsist may be inspected at the offices of the Shoreham-by-Sea Urban District Council, Town Hall, Shoreham-by-Sea, and the offices of the West Sussex County Council, County Hall, Chichester, Sussex, without payment of fee during the usual office hours.

Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing, and addressed to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before 20th March 1964.

The Minister is not, in all cases, required to cause a local inquiry to be held. It is important, therefore, that an objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made, as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.
