BURY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Bury No. 4 Smoke Control Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Bury in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of The Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 16th day of January 1964 made an Order entitled "The Bury No. 4 Smoke Control Order 1964" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of Section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of the building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1964 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Department, Town Hall, Bury, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 1st day of February 1964.
