INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS (IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT, 1950

In pursuance of subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges) Act, 1950 (14 Geo. 6 Chapter 14), Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs hereby gives notice of the following further amendments to the amended list published in the *London Gazette* on the 7th December 1962, as amended by notices published on the 22nd February 1963, the 22nd March 1963, the 6th September 1963, the 22nd October 1963, the 20th December 1963, the 28th January 1964, the 4th February 1964, and the 11th February 1964, of persons who are entitled to immunities and privileges conferred by the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation) Order, 1954. This List shall take effect in relation to each person from the date specified after his name, being the date as from which for the purposes of the said Order in Council, such person first held or ceased to hold the office or employment in question.

Representatives of Member Governments to the Council of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation or to subsidiary bodies thereof (Article 8 of the Order in Council).
