WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (England and Wales)

WATER ACT 1945

Statutory Orders (Special Procedure) Act 1945

HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

Godstone Rural District (Footpath No. 451 Burstow) Diversion Order 1964

Notice is hereby given that on 7th February 1964 the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of his powers under subsection (5) of section 112 of The Highways Act 1959, made the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to divert as from 6th March 1964, the public rights of way over part of footpath No. 451 Burstow which runs from a point to the west of Shipley Bridge to Church Lane, being the part which starts at St. Audrey's Cottage, Green Lane and runs northerly for approximately 280 yards to its junction with Church Lane, to a new line which starts at St. Audrey's Cottage and runs easterly along the existing private road known as Green Lane for approximately 175 yards to "St. Audrey" and thence northerly for approximately 325 yards to the junction of Green Lane with Church Lane, at "Old Orchard".

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order made by the Minister has been deposited at the Offices of the Godstone Rural District Council, Oxted, Surrey, and at the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, and may be inspected during the normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 6th March 1964, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application to the High Court.
