## BUILDING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1959

*Draft Building Standards (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1964*

*Draft Building Standards (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1964*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has published drafts of the above regulations which he proposes to make under section 3 of the above Act prescribing standards in relation to the matters specified in the Fourth Schedule to that Act.

Copies of the draft regulations may be obtained (price 3d. and 8d., by post 6d. and 11d. respectively or 1s. 2d. for a set) from H.M. Stationery Office, 13A Castle Street, Edinburgh 2, or through any bookseller.

Any representation as to the draft regulations must be made in writing to the Secretary of State not later than 13th April 1964. The representation must state the grounds on which it is made and should be addressed to the Secretary, Scottish Development Department, York Buildings, Queen Street, Edinburgh 2.

Before making any regulations under the said section 3, the Secretary of State must—

- (a) if required by any person who has duly lodged representations with him, direct the holding of a public inquiry with respect to such representations;
- (b) consider any representations so lodged and the report of the person holding the inquiry, if any, and
- (c) consult the Building Standards Advisory Committee as to any alteration that he may propose to the drafts.

The Secretary of State has prepared a Memorandum on the draft regulations copies of which can be obtained on application to the Secretary, Scottish Development Department, York Buildings, Queen Street, Edinburgh 2.
