Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963

Direction under Article 4

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government has approved a Direction dated the 28th day of November 1963, made by the Devon County Council as local planning authority under Article 4 of the above-mentioned Order, the effect of which is to prohibit the use of land for the purposes of recreation or instruction by members of an organisation which holds a certificate of exemption granted by the Minister of Housing and Local Government under section 269 of the Public Health Act, 1936, and the erection or placing of tents on the land for the purposes of that use permitted by Article 3 and the First Schedule (Class V) of the above-mentioned Order unless planning permission therefor is granted on application made in that behalf.

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HAMMERSMITH METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hammersmith (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Hammersmith in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 25th day of March 1964, made an Order entitled the Hammersmith (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1964, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of December 1964, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Hammersmith, London W.6, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 3rd April 1964.
