

(iv) From a point 50 yards west of the entrance to Capel Swn at Glyndyfrdwy to a point 7 yards west of the entrance to Colomendy.

(v) From a point 43 yards east of the entrance to the Railway Goods Yard at Corwen to a point 145 yards east of its junction with the Pentre Foelas—Colwyn Bay road (B.5113) at Pentre Foelas.

23. SWANSEA—MANCHESTER TRUNK ROAD (A.51, A.54 AND A.556)

In the County of Chester—

(i) From its junction with the Chester Ring Road (A.41) to a point 243 yards north-west of its junction with Frodsham Street, Kelsall.

(ii) From a point 100 yards north-east of Kelsall Church to the traffic control signals at the junction with A.49 at Oakmere Crossroads.

24. CHESTER—BANGOR TRUNK ROAD (A.55)

In the Counties of Flint and Denbigh—

(i) From a point 440 yards north-west of its junction with the Dolgelly—South of Birkenhead Trunk Road at Ewloe to a point 35 yards south-east of its junction with road A.5026 at Holywell.

(ii) From a point 20 yards north-west of its junction with the Class III road leading to Carmel at Holway, to a point 235 yards east of its junction with road B.5429 at Rhuallt.

(iii) From a point 300 yards west of its junction with road B.5429 at Rhuallt to a point 125 yards east of its junction with road A.541 at St. Asaph.

(iv) From a point 120 yards west of its junction with road A.525 at Bod Erw, St. Asaph, to a point 20 yards west of its junction with the Class III road leading to Rhuddlan at Bodelwyddan.

(v) From a point 580 yards west of its junction with the Class III road at Ty Fry, Bodelwyddan, to a point 630 yards east of its junction with St. Georges Road, Abergele.

(vi) From a point 55 yards west of its junction with Sea Road, Abergele, to a point 85 yards east of its junction with Beulah Avenue, Llanddulas.

25. SWANSEA—MANCHESTER TRUNK ROAD (A.56 AND A.556)

In the County of Chester—

From its junction with Ascot Drive, Plumley, to a point 137 yards south-west of its junction with Park Road (B.5160), Bowdon.

26. PRESTON—BLACKPOOL TRUNK ROAD (A.583)

In the County of Lancaster—

From a point 50 yards west of the entrance to New Lea Hall, Lea, to a point 1,200 yards south-east of its junction with Mythop Road, Blackpool.

27. SHOTWICK — FRODSHAM — WARRINGTON TRUNK ROAD (A.5117)

In the County of Chester—

From its junction with road A.56 at Hapsford to its junction with road A.550 at Shotwick.

28. LONDON — CARLISLE — GLASGOW — INVERNESS TRUNK ROAD (A.6)

In the County of Leicester—

(i) From a point 324 yards north-west of Victoria Avenue, Market Harborough, to a point 30 yards south of Church Road, Kibworth Harcourt.

(ii) From a point 190 yards north of its junction with the Wistow Road, Kibworth Harcourt, to a point 160 yards east of its junction with Orchard Lane, Great Glen.

(iii) From a point 200 yards north of Church Lane, Great Glen, to a point 279 yards north-west of its junction with road B.5403 at Oadby.

In the County of Lancaster—

(iv) From a point 300 yards north of Broughton Crossroads (B.5269 and A.6) to 161 yards north of the Class III road to Bay Horse Station.

In the County of Cumberland—

(v) From a point 200 yards north of its junction with the Old Roman Road, Penrith, northwards to a point 1,066 yards south of its junction with Petteril Bank Road, Carleton.

29. LEEDS—YORK—SCARBOROUGH TRUNK ROAD (A.64)

In the Counties of North and West Ridings of York and in the County Borough of Leeds—

(i) From its junction with Hansby Gate at Seacroft, Leeds, to a point 91 yards west of its junction with Garnet Lane, Tadcaster.

(ii) From a point 490 yards east of its junction with Old Brewery Gardens, Tadcaster, to a point 140 yards south-west of its junction with Sim Balk Lane, York.

(iii) From a point 266 yards north-east of its junction with Elmfield Avenue, York, to a point opposite the property known as "Derwent Bank", 670 yards south-west of its junction with Castle Howard Road, Malton.

30. PENRITH—MIDDLESBROUGH TRUNK ROAD (A.66)

In the Counties of Cumberland and Westmorland—

(i) From the junction of the Alston Road (A.686), Penrith, Cumberland, to a point 300 yards north of Kings Arms Hotel, Temple Sowerby, Westmorland.

(ii) From a point 120 yards north of its junction with Station Road, Temple Sowerby, Westmorland, to a point 30 yards north of the Long Marton Road junction, Appleby, Westmorland.

31. WIDMERPOOL—NOTTINGHAM—BAWTRY—GOOLE—HOWDEN TRUNK ROAD (A.614 AND A.1)

In the County of Nottingham—

(i) From a point 20 yards north of its junction with Mansfield Road (A.60) at Leapool to a point 388 yards south of its junction with the Worksop—Drakeholes road (B.6045), south of Blyth.

(ii) From a point 313 yards north-east of the centre of the roundabout at its junction with A.1(M) and B.6045 north of Blyth, to a point 263 yards north of Gibbet Hill Lane, Hawks Nest, Bawtry.
