RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE LOCAL LOANS FUND NOTICE

The Treasury hereby give notice that, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Public Works Lozns Act 1964, the following rates of interest shall be charged on lozns made out of the Local Lozns Fund on the security of local rates on and after 16th May 1964.

Loans to local authorities as defined by section 10 of the Local Authorities Loans Act 1945:

The amount which an authority borrows within its annual quota will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the lower set of rates. Where authorities borrow further sums these will attract interest at the appropriate rate in the higher set of rates, unless the Public Works Loan Commissioners agree that they should be offset against the following year's quota. Different rates of interest apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by way of half-yearly payments (A) or at maturity (M)

TRIAL OF THE PYX OF THE LONDON MINT
