The Urban District of Horbury No. 2 Smoke Control Order, 1964

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Various Streets, Ilfracombe) (Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Devon Council Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

- (i) to prohibit waiting by vehicles throughout the year (instead of between 10 a.m.—10 p.m. daily from 1st June to 30th September, as at present) on the north-east side of Northfield Road, between Wilder Road and a point 44 yards north-west of its junction with High Street;
- (ii) to prohibit waiting by vehicles between 10 a.m.—10 p.m. daily, from 1st June to 30th September annually (instead of the present unilateral waiting arrangement) in that section of High Street which lies between Oxford Grove and Market Street;
- (iii) to amend the existing Order prohibiting waiting in Ropery Road (Lee Place) between 10 a.m.—10 p.m. from 1st June to 30th September annually so as to exclude the south side, between its junction with Broad Street and a point 300 feet west of that junction.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order for boarding or alighting from vehicles; loading or unloading goods and for building operations, road maintenance and repairs or other similar works.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 8th August 1964.
