MINISTRY OF LABOUR

On 10th July 1964, the Minister of Labour made the Examination of Steam Boilers Reports (No. 1) Order 1964, in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by section 33 (2) and (3) and section 180 (3) of the Factories Act, 1961.

The Order prescribes various forms to be used and particulars to be completed by the competent person undertaking the examination of a steam boiler in accordance with Regulation 3 of the Examination of Steam Boilers Regulations, 1964. The forms are reproduced in schedules to the Order.

This Order, which revokes the Order made by the Secretary of State on 1st June 1938, comes in operation on 16th July 1964.

The form to be used in respect of the examination of a steam tube oven or steam tube hotplate will be prescribed and reproduced in a further Order.

MINISTRY OF POWER

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1935, as amended, he has granted a prospecting licence to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2.

Descriptions of the boundaries of the area were published in the *London Gazette* issues dated 24th July 1959 and 9th September 1960.

Maps showing the boundaries of the area may be inspected on application to the Ministry of Power, Petroleum Division, Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1.

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations 1935, as amended, he has granted to B.P. Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2, six prospecting licences, of which details of the boundaries described from the 2½" Ordnance Survey maps, and with reference to the National Grid, are given in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

An area of approximately 167 square miles in the county of York

North-western Boundary

From the point TA148262 (in the River Humber) the boundary follows a straight line to the seaward end of Salt End Jetty and thence along the jetty to the point TA160274, thence along the High Water Mark of Ordinary Tides to the point TA165272, thence by a straight line to the point TA166271, thence eastwards along the course of Hedon Haven to the point TA191280 (in Hedon). Thence the boundary follows the A1033 road northwards to its junction with the B1240 road, thence northwards along this road to its junction with the B1238 road in Sproatley, thence north-eastwards along this road through Flinton to its junction with the B1242 road in Aldborough, thence along the road via points TA245386 and TA248391 to the point TA258396 (near Aldborough Coast Guard Station) thence by a straight line to the point TA259397 (on the Low Water Mark) of Ordinary Tides).

North-eastern and Eastern Boundaries

From the point TA259397 the boundary follows the Low Water Mark of Ordinary Tides to the point TA399104 (near Spurn Head), thence south-westwards by a straight line to the point TA389077 (in the mouth of the River Humber).

Southern Boundary

From the point TA389077 the boundary follows the County Boundary to the point TA148262 (in the River Humber).

An area of approximately 29 square miles

All that part of the foreshore in the county of York and of the seabed adjacent thereto which is bounded to the north by a straight line drawn from the point TA259396 (near Aldborough) through the point TA300409 to the limits of British territorial waters to the west by the Low Water Mark of Ordinary Tides, to the south by a straight line drawn from the point TA344280 (near Withernsea) through the point TA380310 to the limits of British territorial waters, to the east by the limits of British territorial waters, all the said points being located by reference to the National Grid.

An area of approximately 28 square miles

All that part of the foreshore in the county of York and of the seabed adjacent thereto which is bounded to the north by a straight line drawn from the point TA344280 (near Withernsea) through the point TA380310 to the limits of British territorial waters, to the west by the Low Water Mark of Ordinary Tides, to the south by a straight line drawn from the point TA412180 (to the south-east of Easington) through the point TA440190 to the limits of British territorial waters, to the east by the limits of British territorial waters, all the said points being located by reference to the National Grid.

An area of approximately 26 square miles

All that part of the foreshore in the county of York and of the seabed adjacent thereto which is bounded to the north by a straight line drawn from the point TA412180 (to the south-east of Easington) through the point TA440190 to the limits of British territorial waters, to the west by the Low Water Mark of Ordinary Tides to the point TA398104 (near Spurn Head) thence by a straight line to the point TA391080 (in the Humber Mouth), to the south by a straight
