## Waiting Restrictions

The Minister of Transport proposes to male Regulations under section 34 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, as amended:
(a) to extend the existing restrictions on waiting by vehicles, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive so that they apply to the additional lengths of road in the Borough of Willesden listed in Part I of Schedule 1 hereto; and
(b) to prohibit waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading goods during the same hours in the parts of road in the Borough of Willesden listed in Part II of Schedule 1 hereto (restrictions on waiting, with an exemption for loading or unloading, already apply in these parts of road).

The London (Waiting and Loading at Road
Junctions) (Restriction) Experimental Order 1964
The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he intends to make an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act 1962, the effect of which will be to restrict waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive at a number of selected road junctions in the London Traffic Area.

The sites in the Borough of Willesden listed in Part I of Schedule 2 hereto have been selected as being suitable for inclusion in the experiment.

Exemptions would be provided in both the Regulations and the Order to permit vehicles to wait in order to pick up and set down passengers, to carry out essential services or when used by local authorities in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and, except in the parts of road listed in Part II of Schedule 1 and Part II of Schedule 2 heneto, to load and unload goods.
