*The City of Norwich (Victoria Street, Kingsley Road and Wood Street) (Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1964*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Norwich propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the roads named in column 1 of the Schedule hereunder otherwise than as specified in the remaining columns of the said Schedule.

Exceptions will be made in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary:

- (a) to load or unload goods;
- (b) to enable a person to board or alight;
- (c) in connection with a funeral;
- (d) for the execution of works of a kind to be specified in the Order.

## NORWICH CITY AND COUNTY COUNCIL

*The City of Norwich (St. Stephen's Road—Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1964*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Norwich propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to revoke the City of Norwich (Traffic Regulation) (No. 6) Order, 1960;
- (b) to prohibit any person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait on the west side of St. Stephen's Road between a point 40 yards south of its junction with Chapel Field Road and a point 276 yards south of that junction other than between the hours of 2.15 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. to 11.30 p.m. for a period not exceeding one hour.

Exceptions are made in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary:

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded;
- (c) in connection with the execution of works specified in the Order;
- (d) in connection with a funeral.

## ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight County Council have made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (subject to the usual exemptions) in the following length of road at Benbridge, Isle of Wight.

*Length of Road and Side of Road*

- (a) Sherbourne Street for a distance of fifty feet west of its junction with High Street. South.
- (b) High Street for a distance of fifty feet south of its junction with Sherbourne Street. West.
- (c) High Street for a distance of fifty feet north of its junction with Foreland Road. East.
- (d) Foreland Road for a distance of fifty feet east of its junction with High Street. North.

The Order will come into operation on Monday the 27th day of July 1964.
