

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Roads near Beachley) (One-Way) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th July 1964, the Gloucestershire County Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on any Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday on either of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to that length in the second column of such Schedule.

The Order, which will come into operation on the 25th July 1964, does not apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Lengths of road in Parish of Tidenham, Lydney Rural District

- (1) The unclassified Loop Road, near Beachley, from its northern junction with the Tidenham—Beachley Ferry Road (B.4228) to its southern junction with such road.
- (2) That length of the Tidenham—Beachley Ferry Road (B.4228), near Beachley, which extends from its northern junction with the unclassified Loop Road to its southern junction with such Loop Road.

CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Chester (Park Lane and Bulkeley Road, Poynton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to impose prohibition of waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays only on the following lengths of road at Poynton:

Park Lane—south side only.

From a point 60 yards east of its junction with the trunk road A.523 thence in an easterly direction to its junction with Bulkeley Road.

Bulkeley Road—both sides.

From its junction with Park Lane thence in a southerly direction for 15 yards.

There will be the usual exemptions in the Order to permit vehicles to wait for the purposes of loading or unloading goods, allowing persons to board or alight, or to enable works to be carried out in such lengths of road.

A draft of the Order proposed to be made by the County Council and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned are available for inspection by the public free of charge during normal office hours at the office of the Clerk to the Macclesfield R.D.C., Council Offices, King Edward Street, Macclesfield, and on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday between the hours of 1.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. at the Council Offices, 220 Park Lane, Poynton.

CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Chester (Victoria Street, Congleton) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on the length of Victoria Street, Congleton, from its junction with Bridge Street, to its junction with Twemlow Street:

- (a) Total prohibition of waiting.
- (b) One way traffic—flow of traffic to be from south west to north east (i.e. from Bridge Street towards Twemlow Street).

There will be the usual exemptions in the Order to permit vehicles to wait for the purposes of loading or unloading goods, allowing persons to board or alight, or to enable works to be carried out in such length of road.

A draft of the Order proposed to be made by the County Council and a plan showing the length of road concerned are available for inspection by the public free of charge during normal office hours at the office of the Town Clerk of Congleton.

WHITEHAVEN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Whitehaven (King Street) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Traffic Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th July 1964, the Minister of Transport confirmed the above-named Order made by the Whitehaven Town Council under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the use of King Street (A.5094) Whitehaven between its junction with Lowther Street and Duke Street, to through traffic.

The Order does not apply to vehicles being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the road or in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the road; the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the road; the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.
