Lengths of road in the Chailey Rural District

(1) The north side of the South Coast Road, A.259, at Peacehaven, from the east side of its junction with Cavell Avenue to the west side of its junction with Victoria Avenue.

(2) The south side of South Coast Road, A.259, at Peacehaven, from the east side of its junction with Cavell Avenue to a point 122 feet east of its junction with Roderick Avenue.

(3) The east side of Roderick Avenue, Peacehaven, from its junction with South Coast Road, A.259, northwards for a distance of 185 feet.

(4) The west side of Roderick Avenue, Peacehaven, from its junction with South Coast Road, A.259, northwards for a distance of 137 feet.
