

BOROUGH OF ROYAL LEAMINGTON SPA
The Borough of Royal Leamington Spa (Cubbington Road) Prohibition or Restriction of Waiting Order, 1964.

Notice is hereby given that on 30th July 1964, the Royal Leamington Spa Borough Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit or restrict the waiting of vehicles on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for persons to board or alight, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle, or to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of the road and the services therein. This Order comes into operation on Monday, 31st August 1964.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Market Place, Cirencester) (Prohibition Waiting) (Experimental) Order, 1964.

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucestershire County Council propose to make a further Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on the lengths and sides of the road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, being a local authority within the meaning of section 108 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and operating an omnibus undertaking under the provisions of the Stockton-on-Tees Corporation Act, 1919, and the Stockton-on-Tees Corporation (General Powers) Act, 1930, have applied to the Traffic Commissioners for

the Northern Traffic Area in pursuance of sections 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, for consent to run public service vehicles along certain roads defined in the Schedule hereunder, which roads are situated outside the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees.

Notice is also given that any Local Authority, the Council of any County or any persons who are already providing transport facilities on or in the neighbourhood of any part of the roads to which this application relates may lodge objection to the giving of such consent, which must be in writing in duplicate, and stating the grounds on which it is based to the Clerk to the Traffic Commissioners, 36-42 Low Friar Street, Newcastle upon Tyne 1, not later than the 29th August 1964.
