H.M. CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, namely a Pontiac Motorcar registration no. California DMV 451 (formerly bearing California UYM—404) found at Guiseley, Yorkshire, have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that the said car was at Harwich on 20th October 1963 allowed to be delivered without payment of duty upon condition that it would be re-exported from the United Kingdom when the

importer's temporary stay there came to an end and such condition was not observed. Whereby and by force of section 257 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a solicitor in England who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf, in default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
