

(b) Such a person shall be entitled also to receive compensation equal to

(i) the amount of any damage which he may suffer in respect of his said interest in consequence of the refusal, or the granting subject to conditions, of consent to the demolition or removal of the monument, or to the making of additions and alterations thereto, or to the carrying out of work in connection therewith, and

(ii) the amount of any expenditure incurred by him in respect of his said interest in consequence of the refusal or the granting subject to conditions of such consent.

(4) Any question as to the right of any such person to such compensation or the amount of any such compensation shall be determined by the Lands Tribunal on the application either of the Minister or of the person claiming such compensation.

(5) In the determination of any question as to compensation payable pursuant to this Order it shall be assumed that this Order will at no time be revoked.

(6) Compensation payable in accordance with paragraph (a) of sub-clause (3) of this clause shall consist of a single payment to be finally assessed on the coming into operation of this Order.

(7) (a) Compensation shall not be payable in respect of any diminution of value for which a claim in writing has not been made to the Minister before the expiry of three months after the coming into operation of this Order or such longer period as the Minister may allow showing the amount claimed under paragraph (a) of sub-clause (3) of this clause with such particulars as are necessary to explain how the amount claimed is made up.

(b) Compensation shall not be payable in respect of any damage or expenditure for which a claim in writing has not been made to the Minister before the expiry of three months after such damage is suffered or expenditure incurred or such longer period as the Minister may allow showing the amounts claimed under paragraph (b) of sub-clause (3) of this clause with such particulars as are necessary to explain how such amounts are made up.

4. This Order may be cited as The Gussage Down Earthworks (Part) Preservation Order, 1965.
