The City Council of Liverpool (Central Area) (One-Way etc.) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

1. To revoke the Orders specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order to the extent specified opposite to such Orders in the second column of the said First Schedule;
2. To prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on the roads specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such roads in the second column of the said Second Schedule;
3. To prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle so as to—
 - (a) make a right-hand turn from Gloucester Street into Lime Street;
 - (b) make a right-hand turn from Lime Street into Gloucester Street;
 - (c) make a right-hand turn from Water Street into the Strand;
 - (d) make a left-hand turn from London Road (Northerly Carriageway) between its junction with Monument Place and its junction with Norton Street into Seymour Street;
 - (e) make a right-hand turn from St. Vincent Street into London Road;
 - (f) enter Shaw Street from Islington Square;
 - (g) enter Islington Square from Islington;
 - (h) enter or leave Islington Square at the corner junction with Islington and Shaw Street.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 13th day of April 1965.
