EAST SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

The Stowmarket Urban District (Stowupland Street, Station Road, Prentice Road) One-Way Experimental Traffic Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the East Suffolk County Council have made application to the Minister of Transport for continuing in force of the above experimental traffic order, the effect of which will be to impose for a further period of three months from 29th March 1965 an experimental system of one-way traffic control on a section of Stowupland Street, a section of Prentice Road, and the section of Station Road between its junction with Prentice Road to a point 11 yards to the north-east from its junction with Stowupland Street so that in the section of Stowupland Street traffic shall proceed in a north-westerly and north-easterly direction only, Prentice Road in a south-easterly direction only and the section of Station Road in a south-westerly direction only. The reason for desiring an extension of the Order is to gain further experience of the experimental one-way traffic system.

Any objections to the proposed extension of the Order should be sent to the Minister of Transport, General Traffic Division, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, quoting reference GT. 32/38/01 by 29th March 1965 with a copy to the undersigned.
