*The Caterham and Warlingham Urban District Council (Bridleway No. 78, Caterham) Diversion Order, 1964.*

Notice is hereby given that the above Order made on the 11th day of May 1965, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public bridleway beginning at a point marked "A" on the map hereinafter referred to, at the western end of Magazine Road, Caterham and continuing in a north-westerly direction on the northern side of the disused Magazine and thence in a westerly and south-westerly direction to the Urban District boundary at the point marked "B" on the said map to a line beginning at the point marked "A" previously referred to and proceeding in a south-westerly direction to the south of the said disused Magazine to the Urban District boundary to the point marked "B" previously referred to.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Caterham, Surrey, between the hours of 9 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 21st day of June 1965, and should state the grounds on which it is made.
