

rates for printing craftsmen; a further 12s. increase from 1st January 1966 (of which up to 6s. would be set off against accrued cost of living bonus); and improvements in the cost of living bonus scheme. This follows increases of 3s. in basic weekly rates and 7s. 4d. in cost of living bonus which became payable from 1st January 1965 under the previous agreements and a third week's holiday with pay which came into effect following ratification of the agreement in January 1965.

The employers consider that their pay offer is fair and reasonable, having regard to the general position of the industry and to the agreed national policy for prices and incomes. However, taking into account the improvements that have already come into effect this year, the proposals would appear to be out of line with the considerations set out in paragraphs 11-15 of "General Considerations Relating to Prices and Incomes" (Part I of the White Paper on Prices and Incomes Policy, Cmnd. 2639).

The Government are concerned firstly about the extent to which failure to absorb higher costs in the printing industry by increased productivity and efficiency could result in price increases that would not be in accordance with the criteria for price behaviour set out in paragraphs 9-10 of Part I of the White Paper and which could have a widely diffused effect on industrial costs generally; and secondly, about the possible influence which these proposals, following on the improvements already made, could have on pay negotiations in other industries.

The Board are accordingly requested to examine and report on these issues in the light of the national interest
