TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL
DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1963*Direction restricting permitted development at
Sparham and Great Witchingham*

Notice is hereby given in accordance with paragraph (3) of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Article 4 of the said Order has approved a Direction made by the Norfolk County Council on the 21st October 1964, relating to the following piece of land situate within the parishes of Sparham and Great Witchingham:

All that area of land situate at Sparhamhill forming parcel numbers 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 288, 289, 290, 292, 300, 301, 302, 303, 304, in the parish of Great Witchingham and 59, 60, 62, 66, 68, 82, 83, 83a, 85, 86 in the parish of Sparham (O.S. Sheets Norfolk 38:13 and 50:1 1906 Edition).

The effect of the Direction is to remove the following classes of "permitted development" set out in Part I of the First Schedule to the General Development Order, 1963:

<i>Class Removed</i>	<i>Description</i>
VI (1)	The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, other than the placing on land of structures not designed for those purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings.
VI (3)	The winning and working, on land held or occupied with land used for the purposes of agriculture, of any minerals reasonably required for the purposes of that use, including the fertilisation of the land so used and the maintenance, improvement or alteration of buildings or works thereon which are occupied or used for the purposes aforesaid.

With effect from the date hereof, no development of the classes referred to above can be undertaken without specific planning permission.

NATIONAL PARKS AND
ACCESS TO THE
COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

LONDON BOROUGH OF HILLINGDON

THE OPENCAST COAL ACT, 1958
