LETCHWORTH URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Urban District of Letchworth (North of Norton Road and Wilbury Road) Smoke Control Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the Letchworth Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 2nd day of June 1965, made an Order entitled the Urban District of Letchworth (North of Norton

Road and Wilbury Road) Smoke Control Order 1965 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Letchworth at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 18th day of June 1965.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
