- (i) No waiting 7 days per weeks for twenty-four hours per day in Market Square, Marlow (north-west side) from a point approximately 8 yards north-east of its junction with West Street to its junction with Spittal Street.
- (ii) No waiting (8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. each day) in West Street, Marlow from a point approximately 125 yards west of the western boundary of Quoiting Square for a distance of 96 yards in a westerly direction.
