**NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*The County of Northampton (Church Street, Stanwick) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1965*

Notice is hereby given that the Northamptonshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the north-east side of Church Street, Stanwick, between its junctions with Raunds Road (A.605) and Newbridge Lane, a distance of 262 yards.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from such vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to

or unloaded from such vehicle, to enable such vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the road or services therein.

The proposed Order and a plan showing the length of road affected may be inspected at the offices of the Clerk of the Raunds Urban District Council, Council Offices, The Hall, Raunds, or at the offices of the undersigned.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 5th July 1965.

**NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL**

*The County of Norfolk (Stalham) Experimental (One-Way) Order, 1965*
