(Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1962, Amendment
Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Rotherham propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to amend The County Borough of Rotherham (Various Streets) (Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1962:

- (a) by imposing unilateral waiting by vehicles for thirty minutes in any hour at any time in the length of Wellgate specified in the Schedule hereto;
- (b) by increasing the period during which unilateral waiting by vehicles is imposed on weekdays for thirty minutes in any hour in the length of Norfolk Street specified in the Schedule hereto from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. to from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.;
- (c) by increasing the period during which waiting by vehicles is prohibited on weekdays for a longer period than thirty minutes in any hour in the length of Henry Street specified in the Schedule hereto from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. to from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

 Henry Street on the north-west side from a point 45 feet south-west of its junction with Drummond Street to a point 45 feet north-east of its junction with Effingham Street.

(Restriction on Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Rotherham propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for a longer period than thirty minutes in any hour on weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto on weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto and on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait when in use as part of a funeral cortege or for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic and the maintenance of the roads or the services therein.

(Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order, 1965.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Rotherham propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

(1) to amend The County Borough of Rotherham (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

(a) by deleting the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto from the lengths of road in which waiting by vehicles is prohibited by the Order between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.

(b) by increasing the period during which waiting by vehicles is prohibited on weekdays in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. to from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(c) by increasing the period during which waiting is prohibited by vehicles on weekdays in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. to from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

(2) to prohibit the waiting by vehicles:

(a) at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto

(b) on weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto

(c) on weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Sixth Schedule hereto

(d) on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Seventh Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait when in use as part of a funeral cortege or for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic and the maintenance of the roads or the services therein.
