Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963

Direction under Article 4—No. 21

Linkenholt Estate, near Andover

Notice is hereby given that, on the 31st day of May 1965, the Minister of Housing and Local Government approved a Direction made by the Hampshire County Council under Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, to the effect that the permission granted by Article 3 of that Order shall not apply to the carrying out on the land described in the Schedule hereto of the following development:

"The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, other than the placing on land of structures not designed for those purposes or the provision or alteration of dwellings."

The general effect of the Direction is that planning permission must be obtained before building or engineering operations are carried out on agricultural land in connection with the use of that land for agriculture.

The Direction comes into force on the 10th day of June 1965.
