CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

Rural District Council of Saffron Walden Footpath No. 19 Ashdon Diversion Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that on the 3rd June 1965, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect will be to divert a length of approximately 560 feet of the public right of way which runs across O.S. 224 being the part which starts opposite All Saints Home where it leaves the road east of The Rectory, Ashdon and runs in a northerly direction to Dorvis Lane. The new line of path will be situated 100 feet to the west of the existing footpath and run generally northerly following the western boundary of O.S. No. 192 for a distance of 470 feet and thereafter for a distance of 150 feet in a north easterly direction along the northern boundary of O.S. 192 to join the existing path at O.S. 224. The line of path to be diverted will be closed as a public right of way from 2nd July 1965.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Rural District Council Offices, Debden Road, Saffron Walden, and will be open for inspection free of charge during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the 11th June 1965, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order they may within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application to the High Court.
