AIR FORCE CROSS

Flight Lieutenant Donald Frederick HUGGETT (2554094) Royal Air Force.

On 3rd March 1965, a call for assistance was received at Royal Air Force Valley, from the Motor Vessel "Rolfe" which had on board a seaman suffering from acute appendicitis and requiring urgent medical attention. Flight Lieutenant Huggett immediately took off with his crew in a Whirlwind Mark 10 helicopter. The exact position of the vessel was not known but he set off to find it in spite of a blizzard with gale force winds, visibility down to 400 yards and conditions in which there was a severe risk of icing. After take off Flight Lieutenant Huggett lost sight of the ground above 100 feet and thereafter was restricted to carrying out his flight below this height. The vessel was sighted after 15 minutes but with a sea running at State 8, a pitching vessel and no horizon to guide him he was committed to a high hover to avoid the masts and had to rely entirely on the directions of his navigator to lower the winchman to the deck and eventually hoist the seaman on board. On the return flight to Bangor hospital Flight Lieutenant Huggett had to follow the coastline at a very low height and eventually landed in a foot of snow. The patient was handed over and the helicopter returned to base. On landing it was found that so much damage had been caused to the engine due to icing that it is doubtful whether the helicopter could have remained airborne for many more minutes. The seaman was operated on within one hour of being picked up while the lifeboat which had been launched had to spend several hours trying vainly to regain the harbour in the blizzard. During the whole of this operation Flight Lieutenant Huggett showed calmness, determination and courage of the highest order. His prompt action and complete disregard for personal safety possibly saved the life of the seaman.
