Whereas by Warrant under the Royal Sign Manual bearing date the 8th day of April 1965, We appointed a Commission, to be called the National Board for Prices and Incomes:

And whereas We authorised the National Board for Prices and Incomes to sit as a whole or to sit in the Prices Review Division or in the Incomes Review Division or to sit in more than one Section of the said Divisions:

And whereas We required you the said Aubrey Jones, Chairman of the said Board, where the Board does not sit as a whole, to select for service on any such Division or Section persons from two lists of persons nominated respectively by organisations representing employers and organisations representing workpeople and appointed by Us to be Special Members of the Prices Review Division or of the Incomes Review Division or of both:

Now Know Ye that We do by these Presents appoint the persons named in the First and Second Schedules to this Warrant, being respectively persons nominated by organisations representing employers and persons nominated by organisations representing workpeople, to be Special Members of both the Prices Review Division and the Incomes Review Division of the said Board.
