PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) (REGULATIONS), 1937 AND 1948

Republic of South Africa

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule of the notice published in the *London Gazette* of 9th January 1962, for the importation of meat and meat products from the Republic of South Africa are modified with effect from 1st August 1965, to the extent that recognition is restricted to those Certificates which are completed by the insertion of one of the appropriate establishment numbers listed in the Schedule hereto.

In the case of the label which serves as an Official Certificate, the establishment number shall be inserted between the word "South Africa" and "Government Inspected".

SCHEDULE

In relation to meat, the recognition of the Certificates is restricted to those which are completed by the insertion of one of the following establishment numbers:

31, 35, 37, 38, 40, 41, 43, 46, 52.

In respect of meat products, including canned meat, the recognition of the Certificates is restricted to those which are completed by the insertion of one of the following numbers:

36, 41, 43, 45, 47, 49, 50 or 51.
