The Chelmsford Water (Drought) Order

The general effect of the Order is to modify for a period of six months from the date of the commencement of the Order the limitation imposed upon the Corporation by section 20(4) and proviso (a) to that subsection of the Chelmsford Corporation Water Act 1923 (as amended by section 2 of the Chelmsford Water Order 1948) as to the quantity of water that may be abstracted from the river Chelmer by means of Work No. 1 authorised by the said Act of 1923 on an average in any period of twenty-one days and in any one day respectively by the substitution of "two million gallons" for "one and one half million gallons" and "two and a half million gallons" for "two million gallons".
