

## YORK CITY COUNCIL

*Road Traffic Act, 1930, sections 101 and 102*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of York have made application to the Traffic Commissioners for the Yorkshire Traffic Area for their consent to the running of public service vehicles on the routes set out below subject to the condition that such vehicles shall be run by the Council jointly with the West Yorkshire Road Car Company Limited in pursuance of a working agreement with their Company:

In the rural district of Derwent in the East Riding of the County of York along Fordlands Road, Fulford from its junction with Fulford Road to its most south-easterly junction with Crossfield Crescent, Fulford.
