Any objection to the Order must be made in writing, stating the grounds of the objection, and addressed to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 26th day of July 1965.

The Minister is not, in all cases, required to arrange for objections to be heard by a person appointed by him for that purpose. It is important, therefore, that an objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.

Any owner or occupier of any land to which the Order relates may send to Basildon Development Corporation at the address below, a request in writing to serve him with a notice that the Order has been confirmed, and naming the place where a copy of the Order and of the map and of any descriptive matter annexed thereto, may be seen. Such request should contain a statement of the name, postal address and the interest in the land of the owner or occupier, and particulars sufficient to enable the extent and boundaries of the land to be identified.

NATIONAL COAL BOARD

THE OPENCAST COAL ACT, 1958

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Power, in exercise of the power conferred upon him by section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act, 1958, granted on the 18th day of June 1965, to the National Coal Board an authorisation entitled 'The Hendre Fawr (07024B) Authorisation, 1965, to work coal by opencast operations or cause or permit coal to be worked by opencast operations.

The land comprised in the authorisation is described in the schedule hereto.

A copy of the authorisation and of the map referred to therein can be inspected at the Offices of the Opencast Executive, National Coal Board, Area Office, Banwen, Glamorgan, and at 76 Taff Embankment, Cardiff, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekdays Monday to Friday inclusive.

The authorisation becomes operative on the date on which this notice is first published in a local newspaper, or the date on which it is first published in the London Gazette, whichever is the later date, but if any person aggrieved by the authorisation desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that the authorisation is not empowered to be granted under the above-mentioned Act, or desires to question the validity thereof on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the authorisation, he may within six weeks from the date on which the authorisation becomes operative make application to the High Court under paragraph 15 of the First Schedule to the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) Act, 1946, as applied by paragraph 9 of the First Schedule to the Opencast Coal Act, 1958.
