Water Act 1958

The Hanningfield Water (Drought) (Extension) Order

Notice is hereby given that the South Essex Waterworks Company and the Southend Waterworks Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Two Companies") are about to make application to the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of sections 1 (1) and 4 (4) of the Water Act 1958 for an Order to extend the period of operation of the Hanningfield Water (Drought) Order 1965 which came into operation on 24th February 1965. The general effect of the proposed Extension Order will be to modify for the period from 1st August 1965 to the date upon which the water in the Hanningfield Reservoir (No. 1) authorised by the Hanningfield Water Order 1950 reaches top water level or the 31st January 1966 whichever shall first occur, the restriction on the taking at the points of intake authorised by the said Order of 1950 and at the Blackwater works of the Southend Waterworks Company the waters of the Rivers Chelmer and Blackwater and of the tributaries flowing into the said rivers so as to increase the aggregate quantity of water which may be taken by the two Companies from the rivers Chelmer and Blackwater in any period of fourteen days from an average of 43

million gallons per day to an average of 48 million gallons per day.

Any objections to the application may be made to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, within seven days from the 14th July 1965, and shall quote reference number WS/6026/249/7.
