

# PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

## LONDON BOROUGH OF EALING

### *The Ealing (No. 22) Smoke Control Order*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 4th May 1965, made an Order entitled "the Ealing (No. 22) Smoke Control Order" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke, and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st August 1966, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

A copy of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Town Clerk's offices at the Town Hall, Ealing, London W.5, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 16th July 1965.

Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

### SCHEDULE

All those parts of Cleveland and Perivale Wards bounded by a line starting at the junction of Mount Avenue and Brentham Way, thence generally northwards along the centre line of Brentham Way and the public footpath between Nos. 5 and 7 Brunswick Road, thence generally eastwards along the public footpath at the rear of the properties on the north side of Brunswick Road to the Electricity Sub-Station, thence northwards along the western boundary fence of No. 1 Greystoke Park Terrace to the Western Avenue, thence generally northwards to the point where the River Brent meets the Borough Boundary, thence generally westwards along the centre line of the River Brent to the junction with Perivale Lane thence southwards along the centre lines of Perivale Lane and Argyle Road to the junction with Cleveland Road, thence generally eastwards along the centre lines of Cleveland Road, Castlebar Hill and Mount Avenue to the point of commencement.

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## LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON

### *The Merton and Morden (No. 7) Smoke Control Order, 1965*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the former Urban District of Merton and Morden in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 8th day of February 1965, made an Order entitled the Merton and Morden (No. 7) Smoke Control Order, 1965, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel

other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1966, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Broadway, Wimbledon, S.W.19, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 16th day of July 1965.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

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## PUDSEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

### *The Borough of Pudsey, Farsley (North) Smoke Control Order No. 4, 1965*

1. Notice is hereby given that the Pudsey Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 23rd day of June 1965, made an Order entitled the Borough of Pudsey Farsley (North) Smoke Control Order No. 4, 1965, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of July 1966, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.
