Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Essex intend to apply to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making, under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, of an Order the effect of which will be that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice shall become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Lanes between Cowcombe Hill and Aston Down) (Restriction) Order, 1965.

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucestershire County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of any vehicle (a) the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons or (b) the width of which inclusive of any load on the vehicle exceeds 7½ ft. on either of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto. An alternative route for such vehicles is via the Stroud—Cirencester Road (A.419) and the Cirencester—Minchinhampton Road (Aston Down Diversion).

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable the driving on either of the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to such road; for the purposes of (a) agriculture in connection with land adjacent to such road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land; (b) refuse collection by the Local Authority; in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to such road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, etc., of such road or the services therein.

A copy of the Order and of a Map indicating the length of road to which the Order relates will be available for public inspection, free of charge, at (a) the Shire Hall, (Room 111), Gloucester, and (b) the Police Station, Minchinhampton, at all reasonable hours from 9th to 31st July 1965.

Objections to the Order must be sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport (R.T.C.), at St Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, by 31st July 1965, and a copy sent to the undersigned.

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hertford (Various Streets, Hertford) (No Waiting and No Unloading) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the Hertfordshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to

(a) Impose no waiting restrictions between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the following roads:

1. *Mill Bridge*, A.414. North side—from Maidenhead Yard westwards to the junction with Old Cross, a distance of approximately 260 feet.

2. *St. Andrew Street*, A.414.

North side—from Brewhouse Lane westwards for approximately 175 feet.

South side—from Water Lane eastwards to the existing No Waiting restrictions, a distance of approximately 320 feet.

3. *Old Cross*, B.158. Both sides of road between Mill Bridge/St. Andrew Street and Hartham Lane including the cul-de-sac on the east side of the road and the length in front of the public library, a distance of approximately 450 feet.

4. *Cowbridge*, B.158. Both sides of road from Hartham Lane north-westwards for approximately 45 feet.

5. *Hartham Lane*. Both side of road from Old Cross north-eastwards for approximately 65 feet.

(b) Impose a loading and unloading ban from 8.30 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. and from 12.30 p.m. to 1.15 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the following roads:

1. *Mill Bridge*, A.414. North side—from Maidenhead Yard westwards to the junction with Old Cross, a distance of approximately 260 feet.

2. *Old Cross*, B.158. Both sides of road between Mill Bridge/St. Andrew Street and Hartham Lane including the cul-de-sac on the east side of the road and the length in front of the public library, a distance of approximately 450 feet.

3. *Cowbridge*, B.158. South side only—from Hartham Lane north-westwards for approximately 45 feet.
