Notice is hereby given that on the 28th day of June 1965, the Hyde Borough Council made an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which is to provide that no person, except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform, shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereunder otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to those lengths in the second column of the Schedule.

The Order becomes operative as from the 12th day of July 1965.

LETCHWORTH URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Birds Hill, Dunham's Lane, Green Lane, Pixmore Avenue and Works Road (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1965.
