RHONDDA BOROUGH COUNCIL

Road Traffic Act, 1960, Section 26

The Rhondda Borough Council (Old Penrhys Road) (One Way) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th June 1965 the Rhondda Borough Council made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 the effect of which is:

1. To prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in Uniform any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle along that part of the length of road known as Old Penrhys Road, Ystrad, Rhondda, between the junction of Old Penrhys Road with Penrhys Road and the opening upon Old Penrhys Road of the Tyntyla Hospital gates other than in the direction of from Penrhys Road.
2. The Order shall come into operation on the 11th October 1965.

Road Traffic Act, 1962

The Rhondda Borough Council (Bute Street, Treorchy) (Restriction of Waiting) Experimental Order 1965

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th June 1965 the Rhondda Borough Council made an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act 1962, the effect of which is:

- (1) to prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait upon the Northern side of that length of the Classified Road A.4061 between the Eastern corner of the junction of Cemetery Road with Bute Street, Treorchy and a point in Bute Street, Treorchy 60 feet to the West of the Western corner of the junction of Glyncoli Road with Bute Street, Treorchy between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for a period longer than 20 minutes;
- (2) to prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait upon the Southern side of that length of the Classified Road A.4061 between the Eastern corner of the junction of Cardiff Street with Bute Street, Treorchy and the Western corner of the junction of Howard Street with Bute Street, Treorchy between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for a period longer than 20 minutes.
- (3) Subject as therein mentioned, nothing in the Order prevents any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.

- (4) The Order shall come into operation on the 11th October 1965 and shall cease to have effect on 8th January 1966.

The Rhondda Borough Council (Dunraven Street and DeWinton Street, Tonypandy) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1965.

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th June 1965 the Rhondda Borough Council made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

1. To prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in Uniform any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on that length of the classified road A.4119 between the Southern corners of the junctions of Church Street and Court Street with DeWinton Street, Tonypandy and the Northern corners of the junctions of Bridge Street and Trinity Road with Dunraven Street, Tonypandy.
2. Subject as therein mentioned nothing in the Order prevents any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
3. The Order shall come into operation on the 11th October 1965.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1962

The Rhondda Borough Council (High Street and part Bute Street, Treorchy) (Restricted Unilateral Waiting) Experimental Order, 1965.

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th June 1965 the Rhondda Borough Council made an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the effect of which is:—

- (1) To prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait upon the Northern side of that length of the Classified Road A.4061 between a point in Bute Street, Treorchy, sixty feet to the West of the Western corner of the junction of Glyncoli Road with Bute Street, Treorchy, and the Western corner of the junction of Chapel Street with High Street, Treorchy, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursdays and Saturdays.
- (2) To prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait upon the Northern side of that length of the Classified Road A.4061 between a point in Bute Street, Treorchy, sixty feet to the West of the Western corner of the junction of Glyncoli Road with Bute Street, Treorchy, and the Western corner of the junction of Chapel Street with High Street, Treorchy, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays for a period longer than 20 minutes.
- (3) To prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait upon the Southern side of that length of the Classified Road A.4061 between the Western corner of the junction of Howard Street with Bute Street, Treorchy, and a point in High Street, Treorchy, twenty-five feet to the West of the
