George Street (No Waiting) Order, 1965*

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th day of July 1965 the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Banbury acting by the Council of the said Borough made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in those lengths of George Street, Banbury:

- (1) on the south side from its junction with Broad Street to its junction with Cherwell Street ; and
- (2) on the north side from a point 43 feet east of its junction with Broad Street to its junction with Cherwell Street.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait so long as may be necessary:

- (1) to enable persons to board or alight from the vehicle ;
- (2) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle ;

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th day of July 1965, the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Banbury acting by the Council of the said Borough made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. (a) in those lengths of Gatteridge Street, Banbury:

- (1) on the south side from its junction with Newland Road to its junction with Swan Close Road.
- (2) on the north side from its junction with Broad Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 feet.
- (3) on the north side from the eastern boundary of No. 22 Gatteridge Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 110 feet.

*The Breconshire County Council (Various Streets,
Ystradgynlais) (Prohibition and Restriction on
Waiting) Order, 1965.*

*Lengths of road in the Rural District of Ystradgynlais
in the County of Brecon*

- (1) South-west side of Commercial Street from its junction with Church Road to a point 10 yards north-west of the junction with Heol Maes-y-Dre, a distance of 150 yards.
- (2) Both sides of Church Road from the junction with Station Road to the junction with the Unclassified Road, Heol Maes-y-Dre.
- (3) South-east side of Brecon Road from the junction with Station Road to a point 100 yards north-east of the junction with Club Lane.
- (4) Both sides of Club Lane from the junction with Brecon Road to the junction with Station Road.
