### THE POWER PRESSES REGULATIONS 1965

The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 19th July 1965 he made the Power Presses Regulations 1965.

These Regulations impose requirements in relation to the use of power presses in factories and provide that only competent and properly trained persons shall prepare power presses for use, for the periodical examination of power presses and their safety devices, for the inspection and testing of safety devices after the tools have been set or re-set and before or during each working shift, and for the marking of safety devices for identification and of power presses for identification and other purposes.

The Power Presses Regulations will come into operation on 20th July 1966.

H.M. Chief Inspector of Factories gives notice that in consequence of the resignation of Dr. G. F. Green, an appointment as Appointed Factory Doctor under the Factories Act 1961, for the District of Batley in the County of Yorkshire, is vacant. The latest date for receipt of applications is 28th August 1965.

The Minister of Power, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Electricity Acts, 1947 and 1957 and the Regulations made thereunder, has re-appointed Major A. S. D. Graesser, D.S.O., O.B.E., M.C., T.D., D.L., J.P., as a part-time member of the Merseyside and North Wales Electricity Board constituted under the said Acts.

The Minister has also re-appointed Alderman H. Preece as Chairman of the Consultative Council for the Area of the Midlands Electricity Board, of which, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, the Chairman of the Consultative Council is ex-officio a part-time member.

### PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2(3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted a prospecting licence to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2, and Home Oil of Canada Limited, 18 Austin Friars, London E.C.2, in association, in respect of 190 square miles in the counties of Durham and York.

A description of the boundaries of the area was published in the *London Gazette* of 6th July 1945.

Maps showing the boundaries of the area may be inspected on application to the Ministry of Power, Petroleum Division, Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1.

### PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted four mining licences to BP Petroleum Development Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2. Details of the boundaries of the areas covered by the licences, described from the 2½" Ordnance Survey Maps and with reference to the National Grid, are given in the Schedule below.

#### *Northern Boundary*

The boundary follows a series of straight lines joining the points SK74339307, SK77229332, SK78809328 (on the Walkerith Road) and SK82809278 (near Thonock).

#### *Eastern Boundary*

From the point SK82809278 (near Thonock) the boundary follows straight lines joining the points SK84669061 (at Woodhouse Farm) and SK84008922.

#### *Southern Boundary*

From the point SK84008922 the boundary follows the road westwards to its junction with the A.156 road at the point SK81918855, thence along a straight line drawn through point SK78928904 to the point
