The Secretary of State for the Home Department has issued the following Warrant:

THE CIVIL DEFENCE CORPS (ORGANISATION AND BOUNTY) (AMENDMENT) WARRANT 1965

1. For paragraph 2 of the Warrant intituled the Civil Defence Corps (Organisation and Bounty) Warrant 1962 there shall be substituted the following paragraph:

"Qualifications for service in Class A or B

2. A person shall only be eligible for service in Class A or Class B of the Corps if he holds a senior officer rank or—

(a) in the case of Class A, he has passed such a test or tests as may be approved for the purposes of this paragraph by the Secretary of State;

(b) in the case of Class B, he has completed such a course or courses of training as may be approved for the purposes of this paragraph by the Secretary of State."

2. For paragraph 7 (1) of the said Warrant there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:

"(1) A member of the Corps shall only be eligible for appointment to a sub-officer or junior officer rank if he is serving in Class A of the Corps and, in the case of a junior officer rank, has passed such a test or tests as may be approved for the purposes of this paragraph by the Secretary of State."

3. After paragraph 10 of the said Warrant there shall be inserted the following paragraph:

"Temporary appointments to junior officer rank

10A.—(1) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 7 of this Warrant, any member of Class A of the Corps may be appointed temporarily to any junior officer rank.

(2) A person shall not be so appointed for a period exceeding 3 years, including any previous period of appointment, whether permanent or temporary, to any such rank.

(3) Paragraph 9 of this Warrant shall apply to a person so appointed.

(4) Paragraph 10 of this Warrant shall apply to a person so appointed as if he did not hold the rank to which he was so appointed."

4.—(1) In paragraph 11 (3) of the said Warrant the words "sub-officer or" shall be omitted.

(2) This paragraph shall not be construed as reinstating in a sub-officer rank any person who, by virtue of paragraph 11 (3) of the said Warrant, has ceased to hold the rank.

5. After paragraph 5 of Part III of the Schedule to the said Warrant there shall be inserted the following paragraph:

"5A. Assistant Controller (Operations)".

6. This Warrant shall come into operation on 20th August 1965.

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
- (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road; or
- (e) in the case of any vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when in use as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral;
- (f) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (g) if the vehicle is a fire engine or ambulance or any vehicle in the service of a local authority or police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (h) if the vehicle is a duly licensed hackney carriage waiting upon any duly authorised hackney carriage stand;
- (i) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident;
- (j) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Postmaster General and waiting in any affected length of road while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to that length of road are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to that length of road, or is in use in connection with the cleaning of telephone kiosks adjacent to that length of road.
