PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

GLANFORD BRIGG RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Bottesford, Burringham, Flixborough and
Gunness Smoke Control Order, 1965*

Notice is hereby given that the Glanford Brigg Rural District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 23rd day of September 1965 made an Order entitled the Bottesford, Burringham, Flixborough and Gunness Smoke Control Order, 1965, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemption provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1966 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Rural District Council Offices, Bigby Street, Brigg, Lincolnshire, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 30th day of September 1965.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

An area, of approximately 782 acres, being part of the parishes of Bottesford, Burringham, Flixborough and Gunness in the County of Lincoln (Parts of Lindsey), lying to the West of and adjoining the Borough of Scunthorpe, being approximately 4 miles in length from North to South and $\frac{1}{2}$ mile wide from East to West and comprising the built-up portion of Ferry Road West, Ashby Decoy and the properties on the West side of Scotter Road in the parish of Bottesford, all which area is more particularly delineated on the map referred to in the said Order and thereon edged green.
