

PAIGNTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Paignton Urban District Council (No-Waiting) (No. 34) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that on the 27th day of September 1965, the Paignton Urban District Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is:

- (a) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule;
- (b) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule;
- (c) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 10 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule;
- (d) to amend the Paignton Urban District Council (No-Waiting) (No. 1) Order 1960, and the Paignton Urban District Council (No-Waiting) (No. 6) Order, 1961, by the deletion therefrom of all reference to the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable vehicles to stop to pick up or set down passengers, goods or merchandise and to wait while engaged on the repair of the road or services therein or to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage and in connection with funerals.

The Order will come into operation on the 1st December 1965.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Paignton

Church Street ...	North side, from its junction with Torquay Road to the boundary between Nos. 16 and 17 Church Street. North side, for distances of 45 feet east and west of its junction with Well Street. South side, from its junction with Torquay Road south-westwards for 152 feet.
Palace Avenue ...	South side, from its junction with Torquay Road at Victoria Square to the boundary between Nos. 2 and 4 Palace Avenue. South side, from its junction with Winner Street eastwards and southwards to the south-eastern boundary wall of the Palace Avenue Theatre and for a further distance of 5 yards on the west side of the side road leading to the Paignton Fire Station.
Torbay Road ...	Both sides, from a point 27 feet east of its junction with Parkside Road to the eastern side of the railway level crossing. Both sides, from a point 623 feet east of its junction with Parkside Road, to its junction with Esplanade Road.
Torquay Road ...	East side, from its junction with Lower Polsham Road to the southern boundary of No. 126 Torquay Road.
Totnes Road ...	West side, from its junction with Palace Avenue to its junction with Winner Street. East side, from its junction with Dartmouth Road south-westwards for 38 yards.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Paignton

Road leading from Dartmouth Road to Paignton Bus Station.	Both sides, from its junction with Dartmouth Road to the entrance to Paignton Bus Station.
Well Street ...	Both sides, from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Colley End Road.

THIRD SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Paignton

Kernou Road ...	Both sides, from its junction with Garfield Road eastwards for a distance of 45 feet. North side, from its junction with Esplanade Road westwards for a distance of 66 feet. South side, from its junction with Esplanade Road westwards for a distance of 227 feet.
Oldway Drive ...	Both sides, from its junction with Torquay Road to the main entrance gates to Oldway.
Torquay Road ...	Both sides, from its junction with Hyde Road to its junction with Cecil Road. West side, from its junction with Oldway Drive southwards to the boundary between Nos. 185 and 187 Torquay Road.

FOURTH SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Paignton

Church Street ...	Both sides, from the junction of Torquay Road (A.379) south-westwards for 152 feet.
Kernou Road ...	Both sides, from the junction of Esplanade Road (B.3201) westwards for a distance of 66 feet and from the junction of Garfield Road eastwards for a distance of 45 feet.
Palace Avenue ...	Southern side, from the junction of Winner Street to a point 10 yards east of the north-western boundary wall of Palace Avenue Theatre. South side, from a point 100 feet east of the junction of Coverdale Road eastwards to the junction of Torquay Road (A.379) at Victoria Square.
Torquay Road ...	Both sides, from the junction of Hyde Road northwards for 200 feet.
Totnes Road ...	Both sides, from a point 88 feet north of the junction of the side road leading to back service road to Palace Avenue, northwards to the junction with Dartmouth Road (A.379) at Victoria Square.
